Executive Summary: Introduction & Overview

Attached is the recommended draft cluster plan for the Diocese of Winona *Vision 2016* process. It recommends merging the smallest 21 parishes into larger parishes, and converting their churches to oratory status. The diocese will release the draft for public input at the deanery and cluster levels.

Following assessments in 2011-12 by diocesan leadership and clergy, and discussions in 2012-13 by lay leaders and clergy at the deanery level, draft plans were devised by the Clergy Planning Leadership Group in summer 2014. They then underwent clergy review in September 2014 at the Presbyteral Council, followed by the entire presbyterate (at Presbyteral Days), in order to formalize a consensus model. Clergy at the deanery level then reviewed the recommended plan for possible improvements prior to December. Upon Presbyteral Council recommendation to the Bishop (December 2014), the final recommended draft plan was readied for public release by the diocese (scheduled for February 1, 2015).

After public release, the draft recommended plan will be subject to review by joint clergy-laity meetings at the deanery and cluster level, in accordance with a process designed by TeamWorks International (throughout 2015). After local reviews are complete, the ultimate draft plan will then be presented to the Bishop for consideration (anticipated by Spring 2016, or perhaps earlier in some individual cases). If approved, the overall plan will be implemented according to a time-frame and method to be determined.

The recommended draft plan has the following features:

- clusters (i.e. pastorates) are reduced by 5 as recommended by TeamWorks (2012) for the various deaneries (note: clusters belong to 1 deanery only)
- a cluster should not require more than 3 Sunday/Vigil Masses without a second priest assisting
- a parish with fewer than 70 households or worshippers, and 50 or fewer sacramental activities over a 4-year period, is canonically merged into a larger parish community, and the church will assume oratory status in due course.
- an individual parish must have a weekly Sunday or Vigil Mass (which may alternate among churches of a merged parish if deemed necessary).

The following definitions apply:

- *parish*: a gathering of the people, a community of the faithful; it can possess 1 or more worship sites, properties, etc.
- *cluster*: a group of individual parishes that each retain their respective corporations, assets, liabilities, worship sites, and property.
- *merge*: 2 or more parishes canonically and civilly consolidate their assets, liabilities, worship sites, and property (and perhaps corporations).
- *oratory*: a worship site without any Sunday/Vigil Mass after the parish has been canonically extinguished (i.e. merged or suppressed). A parish preparing for oratory status may first be acquired by a “parent parish” via a canonical merger (instead of suppression). The building may be used for local weddings or funerals (without reserving the Blessed Sacrament) until “closed” (by removing the altar) and suitably disposed of.

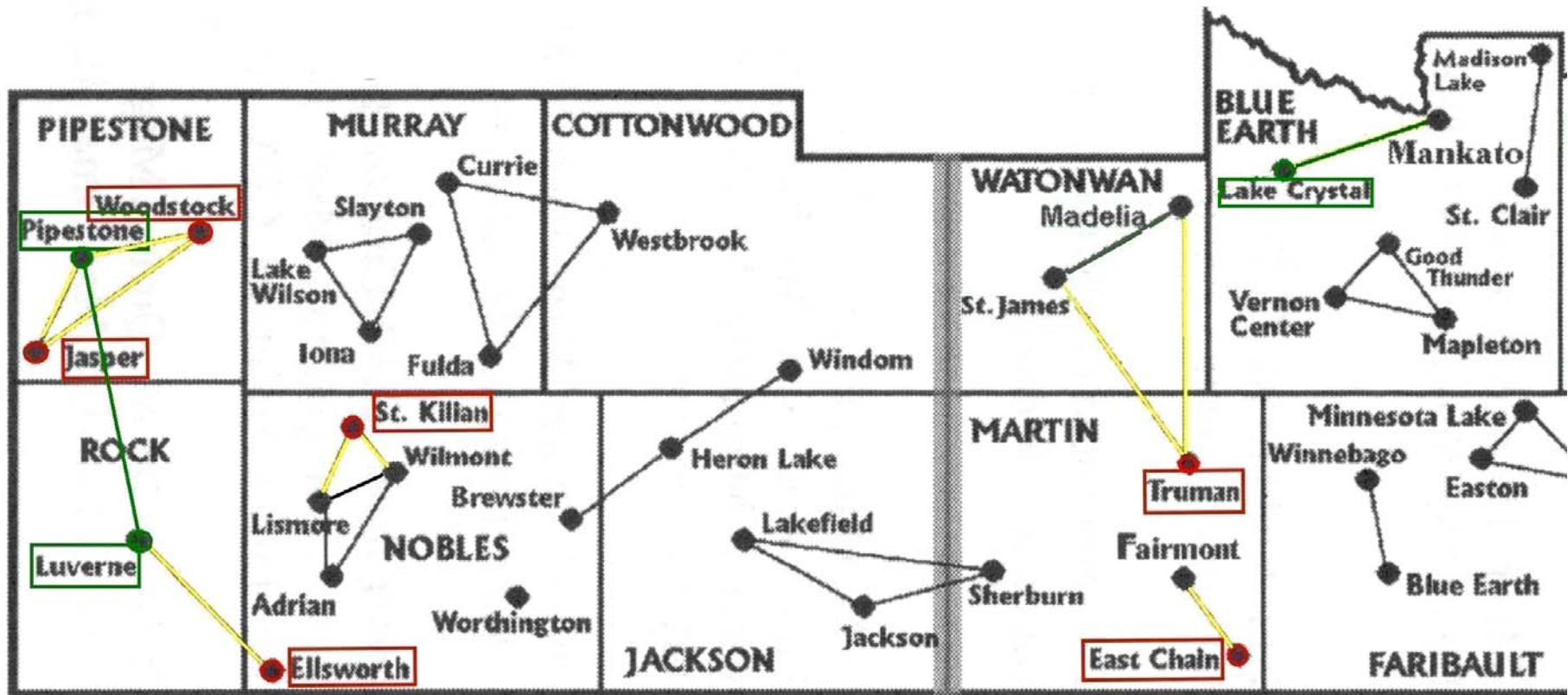

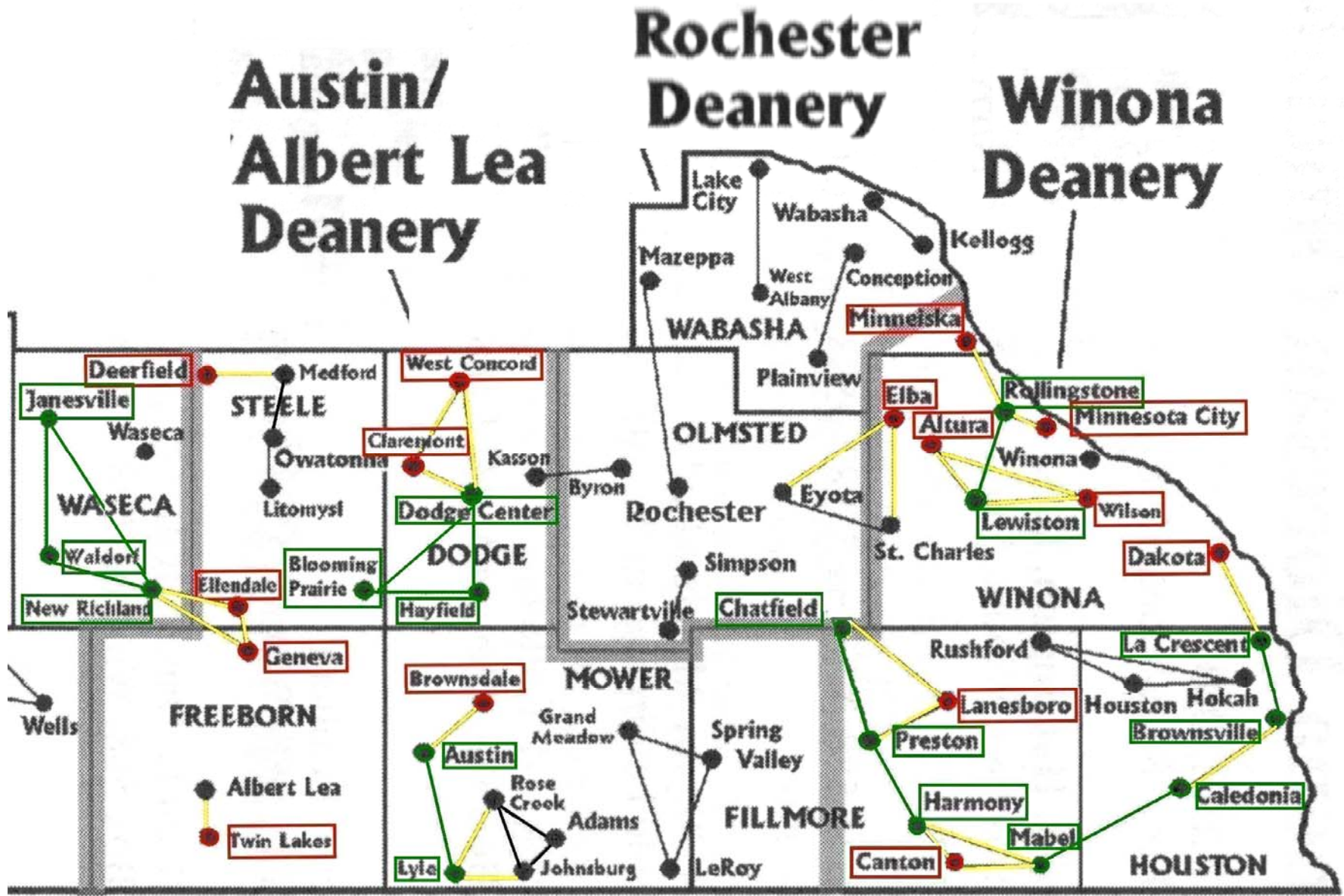

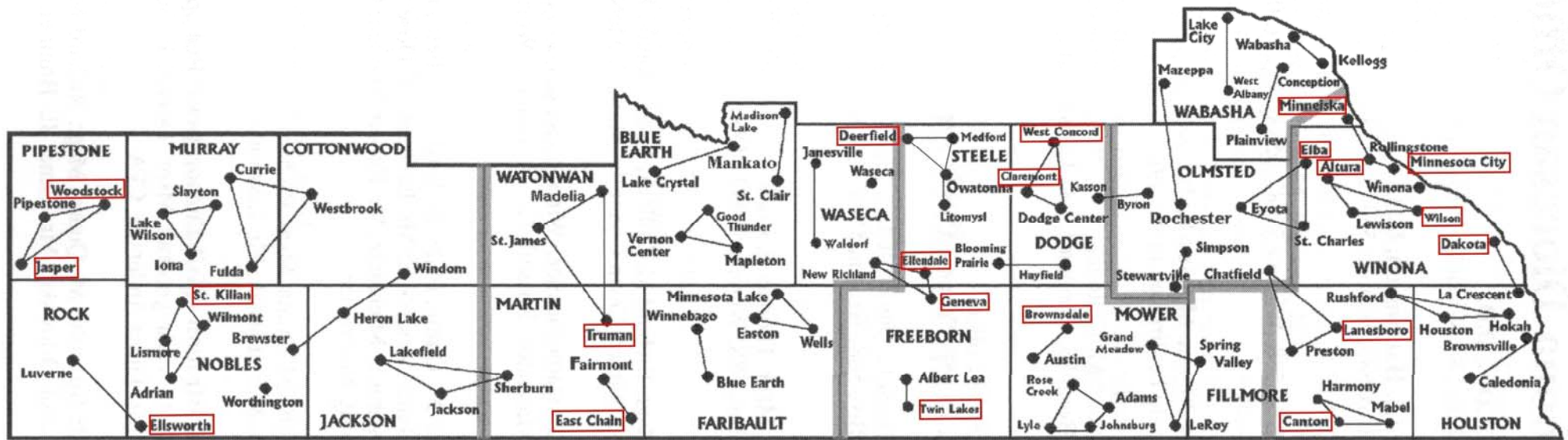

VISION 2016 – RECOMMENDED CLUSTERS (WEST)

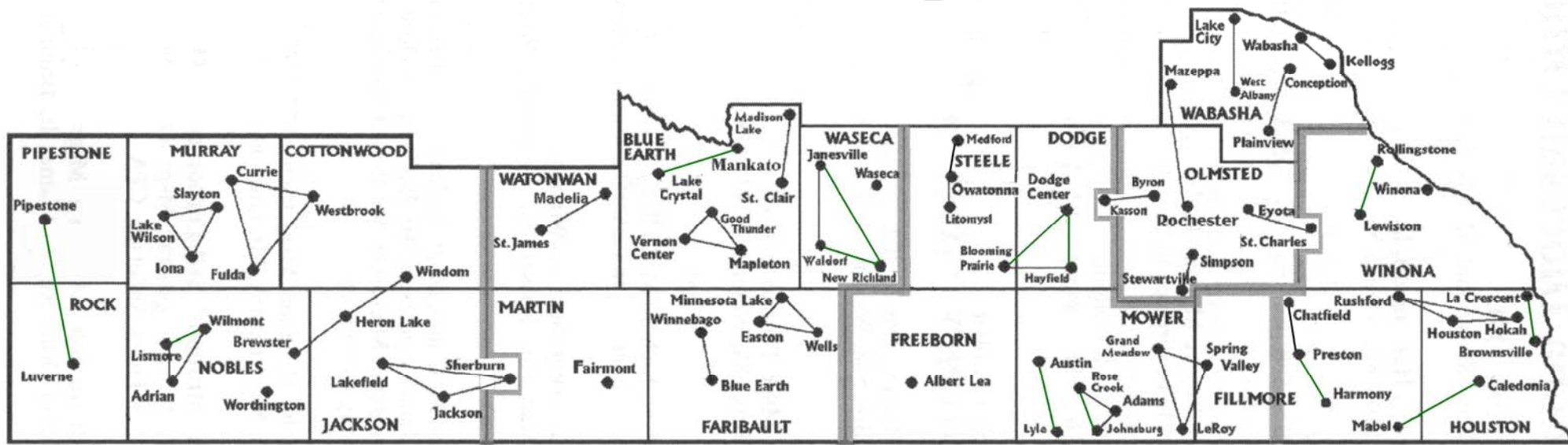


green = new cluster

PASTORAL PLANNING TIMELINE

Diocese of Winona: 2000-2016

2000 – New cluster plan is announced by Bishop Harrington after several years of preparations initiated by Bishop Vlazny. Will reduce clusters from 63 to 51 over several years. Reductions substantially complete by end of 2008, with minor modifications in clusters from original plan.

2009 – Bishop Quinn assumes the See; announces Pastoral Planning as among his priorities.

2011 – TeamWorks International meets with diocesan leadership for advance preparations for Phase I of Pastoral Planning.

2012 – TeamWorks gathers parish and diocesan data, and presents demographic study at Presbyteral Days with recommendations for five fewer pastors in identified areas.

2012-2013 – Pastors appoint parish representatives to gather in deanery meetings of clergy and laity (from autumn through spring) to review TeamWorks recommendations, and suggest how to re-cluster accordingly.

2013-2014 – Phase I of cluster planning is suspended in order to devote energies to the diocesan capital campaign, “Rooted in Faith, Rejoice in Hope.”

2014:

- To prepare for Phase II of Pastoral Planning, Deans are encouraged to refine cluster plans if possible, enlisting the aid of local clergy panels where needed.
- A Clergy Planning Leadership Group meets with TeamWorks to devise “Key Recommendations” for Phase II (July). A further meeting (September) reviews a draft cluster plan, which is then reviewed by the Presbyteral Council, followed by all priests at Presbyteral Days (September).
- Autumn: clergy review the draft cluster plan in each deanery to finalize improvements. A final draft is reviewed by the Presbyteral Council (December).

2015:

- The diocese will publicize the draft plan. Groups of parish representatives will gather with trained facilitators in each deanery and affected cluster, in order to deliberate the draft according to a process designed by TeamWorks. The goal is to submit the ultimate draft plan for the Bishop’s decision by spring 2016.
